Module One: Policy Management

Covering Policy & Programme Management that is at the start of the Business Continuity Management (BCM) Lifecycle. Defining the organisational policy relating to Business Continuity (BC) & how this will be implemented, controlled & validated through a BCM Programme.

Module Two: Embedding BC

This module provides the student with an understanding of Embedding Business Continuity (BC) which is the Professional Practice that continually seeks to integrate BC into day-to-day business activities & organisational culture.

Module Three: Analysis

This module covers the Analysis stage of the BCM Lifecycle that reviews & assesses an organisation in terms of what its objectives are, how it functions & the constraints of the environment in which it operates.

Module Four: Design

This module provides the student with an understanding of Design Stage of the Business Continuity
Management (BCM) Lifecycle that identifies & selects appropriate strategies & tactics to determine how continuity & recovery from disruption will be achieved.

Module Five: Implementation

This module provides the student with an understanding of the Implementation stage of the BCM Lifecycle that executes the agreed strategies & tactics through the process of developing the Business Continuity Plan.

Module Six: Validation

This module provides the student with an understanding of the Validation stage of the BCM Lifecycle that confirms that the BCM Programme meets the objectives set in the BC Policy and that organisations BCP is fit for purpose.
